- Scattering of Ashes: The Vatican last month published guidelines for Catholics who want to be cremated, saying their remains cannot be scattered, divvied up or kept at home but rather stored in a sacred, church-approved place. The Vatican said ashes and bone fragments cannot be kept at home, since that would deprive the Christian community as a whole of remembering the dead. Rather, church authorities should designate a sacred place, such as a cemetery or church area, to hold them. If the family of the deceased don't agree to treating the ashes in this way then a Catholic funeral may be denied. Please see Fr Soji for more information on this subject.
