- ◆ Bishop Walsh School Road Safety Petition: The students of Bishop Walsh School in Sutton Coldfield and the local residents demand improvements to the traffic safety measures in the school's vicinity and on Wylde Green Road and Eastview Road. Over the past several years, Wylde Green Road and the surrounding junctions has been the site of many severe accidents. Students of Bishop Walsh school, with the support of 20s plenty (http://www.20splenty.org/) and Living Streets (https://www.livingstreets.org.uk/), have created this petition in an attempt to prevent any more students being knocked down in front of the school, and to limit the currently excessive number of drivers speeding down Wylde Green Road and Eastview Road, where, combined with the bottleneck of pedestrians and lack of crossing, students are in considerable danger.
